

ORDINANCE NO. 1335

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WILLMAR, MINNESOTA REPEALING CITY CODE
CHAPTER 5, FINANCE AND TAXATION, ARTICLE IV, SALES AND USE TAX AND
MOTOR VEHICLE EXCISE TAX

The City Council of the City of Willmar hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. City Ordinance No. 1097, codified as City Code Chapter 5, Finance and Taxation, Article IV, Sales and Use Tax and Motor Vehicle Excise Tax, which established in the City of Willmar an excise tax in the amount of one-half of one percent on the gross receipts from sales at retail, and the storage, use, distribution or consumption of taxable goods or services, as well as an excise tax in the amount of twenty dollars (\$20.00) per vehicle on the sale of new and used motor vehicles by any person engaged in the business of selling motor vehicles at retail, and provided for the collection, administration and enforcement of such excise taxes, shall be repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after January 1, 2013.
